CSL is looking for a Senior Environmental Specialist to join our Thunder Bay office as our Environmental Services Manager. You will be the technical lead for our environmental division and will manage a dynamic team of environmental scientists and technicians. Your role will include project management and conducting technical reviews of projects related to baseline environmental assessments, hydrogeological studies, environmental site assessments, provincial and federal permitting and approvals, hydrological studies, subsurface investigations, remedial design (soil, groundwater and sediment), and Permit to Take Water technical evaluations.

Key Responsibilities

- Direct and review work of junior staff.
- Provide supervision, training, technical direction and mentoring to more junior staff.
- Provide technical expertise on relevant environmental reports.
- Contribute to and lead business development activities, including proposals, pre-qualifications, and relationship building with clients and prospective clients.
- Identify new business opportunities and support the technical component of business development materials.
- Participate in Health and Safety Policies, Procedures, Standards and Guidelines in the execution of all work.
- Assignments/projects are advanced in nature and require the application of mature knowledge.
- Responsible for planning and conducting assignments/projects having broad scope for independent accomplishment and coordination of difficult tasks.
- Apply technical and business knowledge and methods to develop creative, effective, and economical solutions to address current and potential project issues.
