CSL is looking for an Intermediate Environmental Geoscientist to join our team in Thunder Bay. You will help to manage a dynamic team of environmental scientists and technicians. Your role will include project management and conducting technical reviews of projects related to baseline environmental assessments, hydrogeological studies, environmental site assessments, provincial and federal permitting and approvals, hydrological studies, subsurface investigations, remedial design (soil, groundwater and sediment), and Permit to Take Water technical evaluations.

Key Responsibilities

- Direct and review work of junior staff.
- Provide supervision, training, technical direction and mentoring to junior staff.
- Provide technical expertise on relevant environmental reports.
- Contribute to and lead business development activities, including proposals and relationship building with clients and prospective clients.
- Participate in Health and Safety Policies, Procedures, Standards and Guidelines in the execution of all work.
- Responsible for planning and conducting assignments/projects having broad scope for independent accomplishment and coordination of difficult tasks.
- Execute and manage specific technical tasks or requirements for medium to large projects.
